System Requirements

- Server Platforms: Microsoft Windows NT4, SP3, with IE5; Windows 2000, SP3; Windows XP; Windows 2003
- Server(s) require an existing SQL Server 2000 database or MSDE 2000, SP3
- Client Platforms: Microsoft Windows 95 with IE5; Windows 98/98SE; Windows Me; Windows NT4, SP3, with IE5; Windows 2000, SP3; Windows XP; Windows 2003
- TCP/IP networking installed (Static IP addresses for server)

- Remotely set up applications to "auto-start" and "stay open"

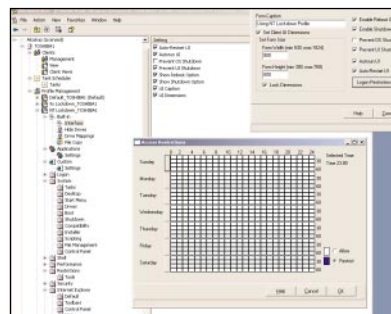
Installation

- Wyse Alcatraz can install the client through various means, including via a custom public web page it publishes

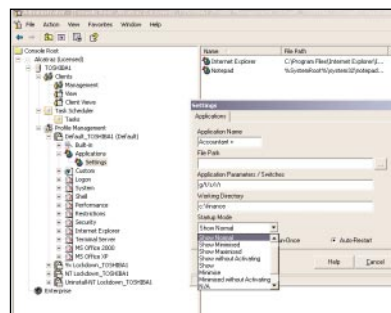

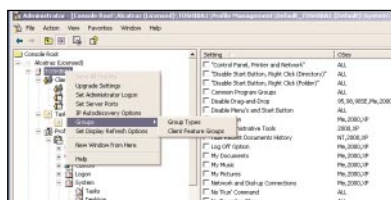
